Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible for a Missouri CASA Specialty License Plate?

Anyone who is eligible to purchase a license plate and/or renew registration in Missouri may purchase a specialty license plate after giving a minimum donation of \$25 to the Missouri CASA Association.

How do I donate to the Missouri CASA Association?

Visit mocasa.org/donate and click 'Donate to MOCASA' or click 'Purchase a Plate' at mocasa.org/plates. When you reach the donation form, make sure to select the 'Missouri CASA License Plate' Donation Tag and indicate your county of residence in the Notes.

Are donations made directly to local CASA programs eligible for specialty plate purchase?

No. To purchase a Missouri CASA Specialty License Plate, you must give a minimum donation directly to the Missouri CASA Association. Your donation will be distributed to a local CASA program based on your county of residence, if your county has a local CASA program. If you do not indicate your county of residence, your donation will go to the Missouri CASA General Fund.

Can I purchase a specialty license plate if I've already renewed my tags?

Yes. You may purchase Missouri CASA plates at any time, regardless of your current license plate expiration date. The Department of Revenue will prorate fees accordingly.

Is there a fee to purchase a specialty license plate?

Yes. Whether applying for or renewing plates, an annual DOR \$15 specialized plate fee is assessed. If renewing for two years, \$30 will be assessed.

Can I transfer my personalized plate to a Missouri CASA Specialty Plate?

Yes. If you currently have a personalized plate, your message or digits can be transferred to the Missouri CASA specialty plate. For a personal message, Missouri CASA specialty plates allow 6 characters for regular plates, 5 characters for motorcycle plates & 4 characters for disabled plates.

How will I know when my Missouri CASA specialty license plate is ready?

The Department of Revenue will notify you by mail when your plate is available for pickup at your local license office.

How does my minimum donation help?

All donations for Missouri CASA specialty license plates help local CASA programs in Missouri recruit, screen, and train volunteers to advocate for abused and neglected children in the foster care system.
